TEAM HISTORY

Football is the second oldest intercollegiate sport at Monmouth College. Monmouth's first football game was played in 1888 against Knox College, a rivalry that still endures to the present. No teams were fielded in 1889 and 1890, but beginning 1891 the Fighting Scots have played continually, except for the 1918, 1943 and 1944 seasons when all games were canceled due to war conditions. The college's first championship team was fielded in 1905, a squad that went 10-1 to be crowned "College Champions of Illinois". The next year Monmouth produced its first undefeated season at 8-0 and was proclaimed "Champions of the Mid-West". After participating in the Little Five and Illinois Intercollegiate Conferences in the 1910s and 1920s, Monmouth entered the fledgling Midwest Collegiate Athletic Conference (MCAC) in 1925 and was declared a co-champion in her first season of competition. The MCAC (men's sports) and MACW (women's sports) conferences merged to form the current Midwest Conference (MWC) in 1994. The conference has implemented various formats to determine its annual league champion, including a North-South divisional alignment which was used from 1976 to 1997. Though many sites have been home to Monmouth football games over the years, the Fighting Scots have used the present on-campus Bobby Woll Memorial Athletic Field for most of their home games since 1981.
